# VII. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- 579 students and growing; class rosters are at the high end to the caps
- Reconfigurations occurred, and was well-received overall
- SSP 6-week segments
- Curriculum Night well-attended; being moved to the night before school next year, with a 15-minute parent meeting at the beginning
- Prep Time has been an issue due to contract increase, but Dave Cormier has been increased from 80% to 90% to help cover the difference
- High-Fives! Kids love them. First was September 30th
- Tutoring available on Monday's through Halifax West from 4-5 PM, and at Trinity Anglican from 2:15 PM 4 PM

# VIII. FINANCIAL REPORT

- \$5,823 will arrive at some point (allegedly); started the 2023/2024 year in a deficit of \$1,400
