#### **Bus Zones**

Did you Know...

There is a fine for stopping illegally in a school bus zone in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and for failing to stop for a school bus when its red lights are flashing and stop arm is extended? Ignoring the rules of these zones can result in a \$410 fine and six points on your license! This applies even if you're not directly in a designated school zone, but rather on a road where a school bus is stopped.

#### Importance of Safety:

- The primary goal is to ensure the safety of children boarding or leaving the school bus.
- When approaching a school bus, it's crucial to drive with caution, slow down, and be prepared to stop if the lights are flashing.
- Never pass a school bus on the right side, where children enter or exit.
- Please be courteous to staff who are trying to ensure the safety of your children!

## Kiss and Drop

We are trying to sort out the best area for parents to drop their children off at the main building if transportation to school is required. If weather permits, and children are capable, walking is a great option! When walking is not possible, we are going to try for a "Kiss and Drop" area for the **morning** only, right after the last Bus Zone sign so vehicles can turn left on Rufus St.
