4. FUNDING PROPOSAL FORM UPDATES (Stephanie)

- a. Stephanie is working on being able to share the funding proposals with SAC members. Stephanie will try to change the access for SAC members so that we can see what proposals are coming in. Stephanie will share previous requests with SAC that have been approved for purchase.

5. PRINCIPALS REPORT (Shauna)

- a. Enrollment is currently at 617 students, up 11 students since last meeting and more are enrolling daily.

- b. School updates: we continue to update our literacy, math and well-being strategies in order to meet the needs of our school community.
- c. African Heritage Month activities are ongoing in the classes and throughout our school community.
- d. We continue to have our monthly High Five assemblies in order to celebrate all of the successes that we see in our school.
- e. Fairview Family Drop-Ins - unfortunately these monthly sessions will no longer be offered due to changes in HRCE/Schools Plus policies
- f. Our school liaison officer was in for a presentation on cyber bullying and cyber safety, stressing the importance of being an “Upstander” online
- g. Traffic remains an ongoing issue at both sites. Admin and staff are present at both sites each morning to assist in safe arrival of all students. Families have been notified many times about the expected practices in dropping off and picking up their children.

6. FINANCIAL UPDATE (Mike)

- a. With one new purchase since our last meeting, we have a running budget of \$4398.43. Wobble stools from Mr. Westhaver (\$60-90/ea for 4) and a class set of headphones.

7. NEW FUNDING REQUESTS:

a) Grade 5 LeBlanc - headphones

- i) 2 - 20 pack of headphones for the chromebooks for her classroom. Total \$136.44 through Amazon - APPROVED for \$300

b) Mr. Estey- library books

- i) Mr. Estey requested \$2000 for new books for the library as well as an additional \$500-1000 per year from SAC. SAC is unable to have yearly commitments without being voted on. Due to the large ask of the request, SAC did not vote in favor. The school will support the library with \$500. Stephanie will respond to the request on behalf of SAC summarizing the discussion.
