WE ARE GROWING! CHANGE IS HAPPENING.

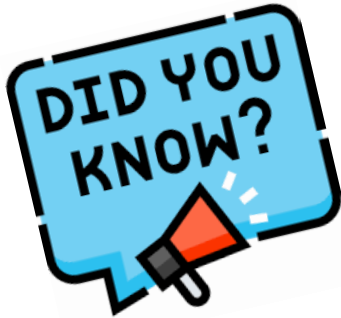

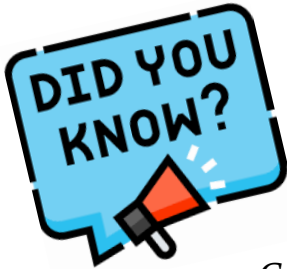
