- Student Success Planning
  - Math and literacy data is improving with further support and alignment in teaching practices
  - Wellbeing is being focused on through teacher-student relationships, and studentstudent relationships – influenced by our well-being survey
  - SSP team is looking to facilitate focus groups to allow students to share their feelings in a more accessible medium
    - Discussion about follow-up, storage and review of information over a longer period
