Principals Report:

- In terms of literacy data, Fairview has has a 19% increase in reading levels at last data check
- Schools Plus Family Drop-Ins are such a community highlight; 60-70 present at the last one! Each month features different things and families are so grateful! In May (16th), they will be doing outdoor activities! All dates have been determined for next year already.
- Spring Fair is coming up on June 8th! Posters are coming and volunteers are needed.
- Still waiting on what will happen with Amy's job
- Staffing allocations have come through, but if they NSTU contract is approved, the number of staff will need to be increased
- Class numbers are increasing to at least 23 homerooms, not including pre-primary
- Arrival time and dismissal time is changing to 5 minutes earlier to support transportation times with the bus company, along with the junior high
- Burton Ettinger pre-primaries will be reattached to Burton Ettinger and moved away from Fairview Heights
